SURGICAL

FACE

- Facelift | Tightens the muscles and skin of the lower third of the face
- Mini Facelift | Ideal for mild skin laxity on the lower third of the face
- **Brow Lift** | Lifts and tightens the skin and muscles of the forehead
- Mid Facelift | Rejuvenates the middle portion of the face between the frown lines and lower eyelids
- **Neck Lift** | Addresses jowls and neck for a more defined jaw and chin
- Eyelid Lift | Removes excess tissue of the upper eyelids and/or fat of the lower eyelids

- Rhinoplasty | Improves the nose aesthetically to harmonize better with the other facial features
- Revision Rhinoplasty | Improving the result of a previous rhinoplasty for an aesthetically pleasing nose that also allows the patient to breathe well
- Chin Augmentation | Creates a more defined chin and jawline and balances the facial profile
- Cheek Augmentation | Enhances the cheek area for fuller, more defined cheeks
- **Lip Augmentation** | Enhances the size, shape, or fullness of the lips
- Otoplasty (Ear Pinning) | Corrects ears that protrude to give them a symmetric appearance

- Deep Neck Contouring | Re-establishes neck and jawline contour by combining submental liposuction with muscle tightening and possible chin implant
- **Neck Liposuction** | Removes fat from under the chin
- Fat Injections | Excess fat is harvested from the neck/chin to be injected into smile lines and/or lips
- Skin Resurfacing (Peels, Dermabrasion, CO2 Laser) | Removes the outer layer of the skin using abrasion, chemicals, or laser to correct lines, wrinkles, and pigment changes
- Mohs Reconstruction | Restores form and function to the head and neck after skin cancer has been removed

BREAST AND BODY

- **Breast Augmentation** | Uses implants to increase the size of breasts, restore volume, achieve a more rounded shape or correct breast asymmetry
- **Breast Lift** | Repositions the breasts by removing excess skin and tightening the surrounding tissue to reshape and support the breast contour
- Breast Augmentation with Lift | Restores the breasts to their previous position and shape while addressing lost volume
- Breast Augmentation with Fat Transfer | Uses fat from your own body obtained through liposuction to enhance the breasts
- Male Breast Reduction | Restores a flatter, firmer and more masculine contour to the chest

- Tummy Tuck | Creates a flatter, smoother abdomen by removing excess fat and skin
- Mommy Makeover | Combines a tummy tuck, liposuction, and breast procedure to restore a woman's shape after pregnancy and childbirth
- **Liposuction** | Removes unwanted fat and sculpts areas of the body such as the waist, arms, thighs, buttocks, and stomach
- Smartlipo™ Laser Body Sculpting | Reduces unwanted fat with the added benefit of tightening loose skin at the same time

- **Arm Lift** | Removes excess fat and loose skin on the upper arms
- Thigh Lift | Elevates the fat and skin of the inner or outer thighs
- Bra Line Back Lift | Minimizes rolls found on the back by removing excess skin and fat
- Body Contouring after Weight Loss Surgery | Removal of excess skin after massive weight loss
- Labiaplasty | Surgical re-contouring of the labia

HAIR

- Follicular Unit Transplantation (FUT) | Removes a strip of hair-bearing skin from the back of the scalp to harvest and transplant grafts
- Follicular Unit Extraction (FUE) | Extracts and transplants donor hair with no excision, preferable for patients who wear their hair short
- Eyebrow Transplant | Restores lost or thinning brows

NON-SURGICAL

FACE

- Botox® | Minimizes early signs of aging in the forehead and crow's feet areas and can be used for jawline contouring in the masseter
- Injectable Fillers | Minimally invasive fillers correct a variety of concerns, such as wrinkles, fine lines, and volume loss and can be used to perform a non-surgical rhinoplasty
- **PrecisionTx™ for Facial Contouring** | Laser treatment to contour the jawline and neck
- **Split Earlobe Repair** | Restores the appearance of earlobes that have been torn or stretched
- **Lip Augmentation** | Enhances the fullness and shape of the lips with injectable fillers
- Non-Surgical Rhinoplasty | Contours the nose using injectable fillers
- Skin Resurfacing (Peels, Dermabrasion) | Resurface a small area of the outer layer of skin to minimize acne and other scars, lines and wrinkles

BREAST AND BODY

- Inverted Nipple Repair | Corrects nipples that are flat or inward
- Nipple Reduction | Reduces prominent nipples
- Areola Reduction | Reduces the size and area of the areola
- Scar Revision/Therapies | Used to enhance the healing of scars and reduce their visibility
- **QWO Injections for Cellulite** | Treats moderate to severe cellulite in the buttocks

HAIR

- Platelet-Rich Plasma for Hair Restoration | In-office procedure to help reverse hair thinning and encourage new hair growth using PRP, the portion of your blood that contains growth factors
- 82F/82M | Topical prescription solutions designed to regrow hair by promoting scalp health and helping to restore hair follicles to their normal function

LINDSAY HOUSE SURGERY CENTER

The surgery center offers two operating rooms and two procedure rooms, and fully equipped preoperative and post-anesthesia care areas - to provide the highest level of care and safety in outpatient surgery. Built in 1878, the Lindsay House reflects a time in our nation's history when industry and ingenuity were on the rise. The Rochester area, like so many cities across the nation, flourished in wealth and grandeur as our nation collectively enjoyed an era of innovation and expanded commerce. Wealthy inhabitants displayed their great success through the construction of stately homes and mansions. One such mansion, located across the street from the historic Eastman House, is the Lindsay House.

Over a century had passed, and the Lindsay House had fallen into dramatic disrepair. Present day owner, Vito C. Quatela, M.D., had long held the vision to build a medical practice within a restored historical building. Purchased in 1992, he began the long and challenging journey of making his dream a reality. The home we see today was made possible through the desire and creative vision of one man to capture the original sweeping beauty and architectural grandeur of yesteryear. The project took perseverance, patience, aesthetic precision and great respect and love of the past.

HISTORY OF THE HOUSE



The Lindsay House was built in 1878 by Alexander Millar Lindsay, of Sibley, Lindsay and Curr. He built the house for his wife, four daughters and three sons. The house was a three-story Victorian mansion designed by James G. Cutler. The homestead extended from Barrington to Berkeley, and from East Avenue to Park Avenue.

Over the next twenty years, considerable changes were made to the house. In 1900, the sun room was added. It was the "crowning glory" to Mr. Lindsay's creation and provided the future setting for the weddings of all four Lindsay daughters.

The sun room overlooks a boxwood rose garden originally designed by renowned landscape architect Allen DeForest. DeForest also designed gardens and landscapes for Eastman, Bausch, Lomb and Gannett in the Rochester area. Mr. Lindsay resided in the home until his death in 1923. He was eulogized by George Eastman in a wake conducted in the sun room.

The home remained in the Lindsay family until the late 1940's when it was donated to the Rochester Health Association, which provided needed community services, including Operation Friendship.

IMPECCABLE RESTORATION

The Lindsay House came to the market and was purchased by Vito C. Quatela, M.D. in 1992. Dr. Quatela soon entered into a complete historical restoration and expansion project on the house's exterior, interior and gardens. During the restoration project, the historic garden was painstakingly moved off site to a nursery. It was returned to the site in sections and replanted in its original 1900 form when renovations were completed.

The Lindsay House is now home to the Quatela Center for Plastic Surgery, Lindsay House Surgery Center, Quatela Center for Hair Restoration and Q the Medical Spa at Lindsay House located on the third floor.
