Dr. Montague often recommends a combination of surgical and non-surgical options, such as platelet-rich plasma (PRP) therapy, prescription topical treatments, and oral supplements like Nutrafol. Surgical options include:

Follicular Unit Transplantation (FUT): FUT, or the strip method, involves removing donor hair from the back of the head, where the follicles are less likely to be lost, and transplanting them to areas with thinning hair. Patients undergoing FUT receive trichophytic closure, an overlapping technique that minimizes scarring by permitting hair to grow through the incision, helping it blend in effectively.

Follicular Unit Extraction (FUE): The Devroye WAW system guarantees precise graft harvesting and keeps a low transection rate (hair units damaged during extraction) to deliver natural-looking results.

PRP therapy is then strategically incorporated into all hair restoration surgeries, as it improves graft survival and speeds up growth. Lastly, natural-looking hairlines are crafted by using single hair grafts at the front and adding subtle irregularities to the design to prevent a harsh or straight-line appearance and ensure seamless blending with existing hair.

"We take a comprehensive approach to hair restoration, combining advanced techniques, a dedicated team, surgical and



nonsurgical options, and personalized, natural-looking results," says Dr. Montague. "We identify the cause of hair loss and provide consultations and evaluations to help each patient choose the best approach."
